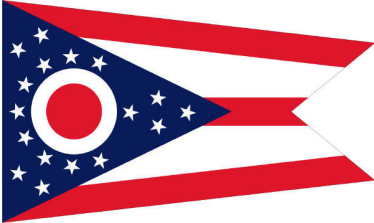

**August 12** - GOP Picnic in Orrville

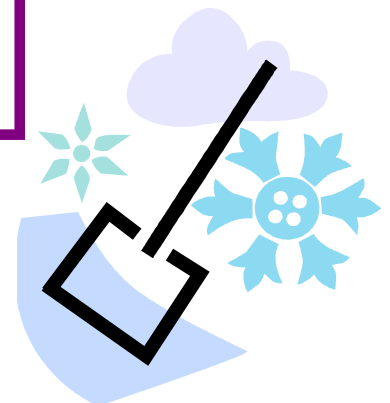

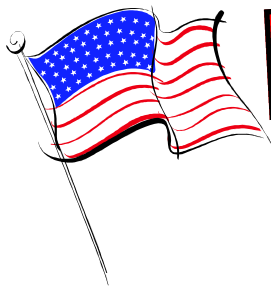
